24th January – talk by local historian, David Glover, Saturday at 2pm. Tickets £5 which will include tea/coffee/cake. Classes resume in the hall.

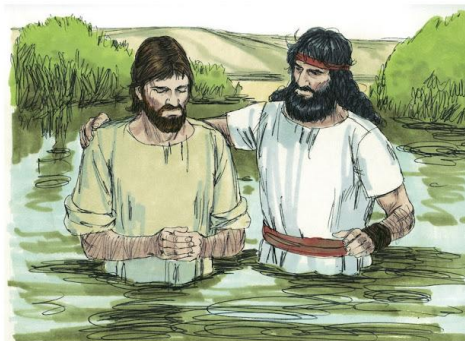
